Sister Jane is living in a retirement Convent in San Francisco. I contacted a mutual friend who was willing to arrange the visit for Monday February 16th, which was the President's Day holiday.

Soon I found myself in a large, pleasant, building with lots of big windows waiting for my friend and his wife to arrive. The Volunteer receptionist, Sharon, chatted about what good care the elderly sisters receive and how wonderful the food is that they serve the residents.

Before long we were taken to Sister Jane's small cheery room. She

was visibly delighted to see my friends. She had a million questions for me about staff and volunteers. She wanted to make sure we still had the dog pen for our guests with four legged friends. She wanted to hear about all our fundraising efforts.

She was delighted to learn about a large donation we received at Christmas from a gentleman in Los Angeles who had never even been to Ukiah. Years ago he and his sister had seen the movie about Sister Jane on a cable channel When they had an opportunity to make a substantial donation they chose Plowshares because of Sister's commitment which inspired the support of the local community.

When I left, I felt so lucky to be able to bring good news about Plowshares to Sister Jane. We stand on the shoulders of the visionary people who began our work in 1983 with nothing much but faith and the desire to help the hungry. It is a pleasure to be able to let our founders know that their work continues to bring comfort to thousands each year, one meal at a time. And it is also a pleasure to say to those who inquire, "Sister Jane is doing just fine!"


